	Halloween attire suggested!  ProShop will create A,B,C,D teams. Play from your designated tee. The team selects the best shot and marks that ball. The person's whose ball was selected "steps aside" and the other players play the next shot, placing or dropping their ball within one club length of the selected ball's position (and within six inches on the putting green), no closer to the hole. Repeat the process until the ball is holed out.  • Must use each player's drive once. • When placing/dropping the ball, it must remain in the same condition (hazard, sand, rough, etc.)  1st place awards will go to the teams with the lowest score, for the front and back nine.

Nov 17, 2025	Mulligan Monday
	Play from your designated tee. Mark the scorecard with your gross and net score for each hole.  • Players have the option to use <b>one</b> Mulligan on <b>one</b> drive AND <b>one</b> Mulligan on <b>one</b> putt.  • Circle your hole score when you use a Mulligan.
	1 <sup>st</sup> and 2 <sup>nd</sup> place awards for low net front and back nine.
	Let the Pro Shop know if you have birdies or chip-ins on a hole where you <b>did not use a mulligan</b> . If mulligans were <b>not used</b> , your gross score is eligible for GHIN entry and Ringerboard.
Dec 1, 2025	Bingo, Bango, Bongo! Play from your designated tee. Mark scorecard with your gross and net score along with your bingo, bango bongo points.
	On each hole a point is awarded to the player who gets on the green first, a point to the player who is closest to the hole, and a point is given to the player who sinks the first putt. Be careful to observe 'honors' on the approach to the green as well as on the green. 1st and 2nd place awards go to the front nine and back nine players with the most points.
	Let the Pro Shop know if you have birdies or chip-ins. Your gross score is eligible for GHIN entry and Ringerboard.

Dec 8, 2025	Food Drive Bring non-perishable food items for donation to the South County Food Bank. Deduct one stroke for each item you bring, up to 5 items.
	Play from your designated tee. Mark the scorecard with your gross and net score for each hole. At the end of your round deduct 1 stroke from your net score for each non-perishable food item you brought – up to 5 strokes can be deducted. 1st and 2nd place awards go to the low net front and back nine players.
	Let the Pro Shop know if you have birdies or chip-ins. Your gross score, without food deduction, is eligible for GHIN entry & Ringerboard.

	At the end of the round subtract from your total net score, the net scores for the 3 holes you circled. 1st and 2nd place awards go those with the lowest "adjusted" net score for the front and back nine.

If a ball is lost or incurs a penalty, continue to alternate shots.
	Holes 10 – 18 Partner Scramble  Each player plays from their designated tee. Both partners tee off and the best shot is selected and marked. Both partners hit their next shot from the marked position and the best shot is selected and marked. This continues until the ball is holed out. Except for the tee shot, the ball should be placed or dropped within one club length of the selected ball's marked position (and within six inches on the putting green), no closer to the hole.  • Must use each player's drive once.  • When placing/dropping the ball, it must remain in the same condition (hazard, sand, rough, etc.)

Feb 23, 2026	Lucky Roll Play from your designated tee. Mark the scorecard with your gross and net score for each hole. After the round, each player rolls one die. The number on the die indicates how many hole scores the player can subtract from their net score. Example: Player rolls a "3". They can deduct their three worst holes from their score. 1st and 2nd place awards go to the front nine and back nine players with the lowest net score after the dice roll.
	Let the Pro Shop know if you have any birdies or chip-ins and your gross score is eligible for GHIN entry and Ringerboard.
Mar 2, 2026	Special Event – WGA 9 Member Guest  This event is open to all WGA 9 members and their guests. Look for the special sign-up sheet on WGA 9 bulletin board. All participants will play from the #1 tees.
