WGA 18H – UPS Cup *** U Play Spectacular *** Season Long Points Competition

The WGA 18H is proud to announce the inaugural year of the UPS Cup – Season Long Points Competition.

All current members of the WGA 18H will be eligible to earn points every week. No additional entry fee is required to participate.

The Points Competition will run from 10/19/23-4/18/24 (or 4/23/24 Rain Date for Club Championship).

Points earned will be noted on the weekly event payout sheets and a running total will be included on the WGA website. The WGA Tournament Committee is responsible for updating the website with weekly point updates; in addition, the Tournament Committee will keep a written copy of all point distributions.

In addition to earning points for winning prize money in weekly events, WGA members will also earn Participation Points for weekly play and luncheon/meeting attendance.

Tier One is comprised of our three major tournaments during the season (President's Award, Buddy Tournament, and Club Championship). These events will have greater point values for the Overall Event Winner(s) as well as First/Second/Third Place Flight winners.

Tier Two includes team events (Opening Day Step Aside Scramble, Holiday Tournament, 9H/18H Member-Member, 3-2-1 Switch it Up Scramble, 3 Jills & A Jack and the Closing Day Shamble).

Tier Three are the regular weekly events (not included in Tiers One and Two) both flighted and non-flighted. Both the Valley Cup and Mission Match Play each have their own point values.

In the event of any ties where a scorecard playoff does not ensue, the points allocated for that particular finishing place will be split evenly between two (or more) tied scores.

No points will be awarded for the WGA Guest Day Event, Weekly Closest to the Pin or Birdies/Chip Ins.

The WGA Tournament Committee reserves the right to adjust any point allocations as needed and will make WGA membership aware of such changes. There will be no adjustments to the actual list of events included in the competition.

At the end of season, at our Closing Day Luncheon, the participants and format of the UPS WGA Shootout (to be held on Thursday 5/2 PM Tee Times) will be announced. Money prizes will be awarded to all participants of the Shootout.

WGA members not participating in the UPS WGA Shootout will be invited to cheer on the participants as they make their way around the course.
