

MISSION VALLEY LOCAL RULES

Sandscape Cart Paths: A player does not get relief on cart path areas that are sandscape, the sandscape is considered part of the course, so player needs to play the ball as in lies. The only cart paths that players get relief from are the paths made of asphalt or concrete.

Embedded Ball In Face of Bunkers: When a player's ball is plugged in the upslope or face of the bunker, they may take relief by placing the ball on the flat portion of the bunker. The ball must be plugged on the upslope or the face of the bunker for relief.

Sprinkler Head (Around Greens): Sprinkler heads located within two club lengths of the green and within two club lengths of the ball are immovable obstructions. Relief may be taken when the sprinkler head intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole; lift and drop the ball at the nearest point where the ball lays that is not closer to the hole; avoids intervention and is not on the putting green
